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## Hume Whittlesea Pharmacy Waiver Program

**This service is run in partnership with Whittlesea Community Connections Epping**



### Our Service:

The Hume and Whittlesea Pharmacy Waiver Program aims to give people seeking asylum who have no income access to essential medications.

### Who can use this program?

You may be eligible for Pharmacy Waiver Program if you:

- Are a person who is seeking asylum on a Bridging Visa
- Live in the City of Whittlesea or Hume
- Need support to access your essential prescription medications
- Have no regular income
- Are not receiving support through SRSS payments

**Unfortunately we are not able to fund non-essential or over the counter medications.**

### Evidence of eligibility:

We do require some personal information and documentation about our clients to ensure they are eligible for our program. This includes a referral form (completed by your case worker or our waiver program coordinator), copy of your visa documentation and copy of bank statements.
